POSITION TITLE – SENIOR ATHLETIC TRAINER, CERTIFIED (ATC)

MAIN TASK AND ACTIVITIES:

- Supervise and provide guidance to a small team of Athletic Trainers, Certified (ATC)
- Manage the administration, budgeting, planning and acquisition of orthopedic and sports medicine supplies
- Senior ATC is required to ensure the athletic trainers are able to demonstrate an ability to perform the following functions regarding athletic injuries: prevention, assessment, treatment, (including first aid and emergency response)
- Senior ATC is required to ensure the athletic trainers are able to demonstrate proper taping, strapping, bracing, and fitting of athletic equipment.
- Senior ATC is required to ensure the athletic trainers will carry out all prescribed treatments and recommendations by the team/program/event physician.
- Senior ATC is required to ensure all athletic trainers will maintain certification in accordance with those respective institutions.
- The team of athletic trainers will cover assigned pre-season physicals, sports games or matches, and related events under the supervision of the program manager.
- The athletic trainers must demonstrate knowledge of the principals of growth and development over the life span and possess the ability to assess data reflective of the athletes status and interpret the appropriate information.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENT AND EXPERIENCE:

- Minimum of Bachelor's Degree in Athletic Training or related field (e.g. NATA equivalent)
- Minimum 5 years in athletic training setting preferred
- More than two (2) years of experience in a supervisory/ management role

- The ability to work as a member of a team as well as autonomously
